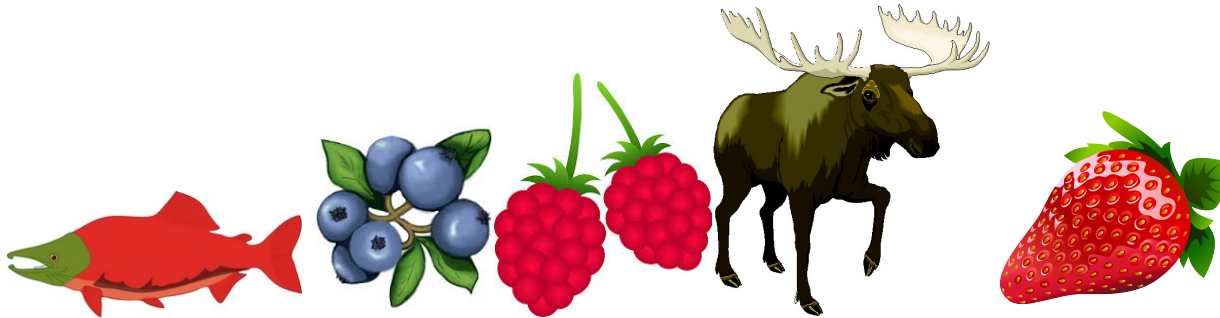


# Do you hunt, fish, or gather berries?
